	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist the clients on and off the bus as needed • Assist with personal shopping as needed • Assist with the seating of clients at some events. • Monitor the whereabouts of clients. • Assure that all clients have returned to the bus. • Assist the bus driver with walkers/wheelchairs • Socialize and engage clients in conversation • To assist in the collection of entrance fees, tickets, etc. as required.

<p>Commitment required:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shopping program scheduled for 2nd and 4th Tuesday each month • Activities usually last 3 to 3.5 hours, and may be scheduled for morning, afternoon or evening depending on the event. • 3 month commitment is required
<p>Training required:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend one outing and ride the bus to observe the volunteer • Orientation as provided by the Volunteer and/or Program Coordinator
