Duties:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To represent the Communications Manager and Seniors Services Society at local Seniors Wellness/Health and Information Fairs • Attending local community events hosting seniors services society information table as a representative • Arrive at location of the community event 15 minutes prior to start time • Arrange information brochures and hand outs and display board • Talk to people who visit the information display
Skills required:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Neat and tidy appearance • Must read and speak English fluently • Must work well with others • Must be comfortable talking to a variety of people
Special requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Punctual and reliable • Physically able to carry medium weight display board • Provide own transportation or able to use transit
Commitment required:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When needed, mostly weekends several times a year
